<p>Amritlal Nagar (1916-1990) was one of the greatest modern Hindi novelists and he is still well known for many of his research based novels. However, he wrote more than seventy short stories, too. In his short stories he tried to depict various aspects of human life of Indian people. It was very interesting to find out similarities and differences between his novels and short stories. In both ways, content-wise and form-wise. In my Research Plan the main goal was to shed light on Amritlal Nagar's world vision and perspectives for his writing short stories. And I wanted to know the situations of the society of that time. Also a comparative study with Premchand (1880-1936) and his short stories.</p> <p>He highlighted the problems of deprived sections of Indian society. Especially poor and old, women, prostitutes, laborers, boastful but problem facing persons, in other words, all kinds of people are the target of Amritlal Nagar's writing. In his short stories he narrated in Lucknow's particular dialect, mixture of Hindi and Urdu words.</p> <p>My article titled as 'Amritlal Nagar's Short Stories' was completed and already sent to the editor of Hindi Journal SAMVED.
