I am currently in the final stages of completing my Ph.D. dissertation, which I plan to submit in June 2016.

My dissertation offers a cross-linguistic study investigating the patterns of semantic extension observed for English phrasal verbs and Japanese lexical compound verbs.

In September 2015, I gave a presentation at the 24th meeting of *Nihongo Nihonbunka Kyoiku Kenkyukai* (NNKK) on "profile shift" in complex predicates in English and Japanese.

I also joined a research team as co-investigator on a project investigating factors affecting the career success of graduates from foreign language departments of Japanese universities.
