- 1. I conducted research on Peruvian Spanish. I focused my investigation on the periphrasis < estar que + verb> which is widely used in Northern Peru instead of <estar + gerund>, which is used in standard Spanish to express the present continuous tense. As the use of the periphrasis < estar que + verb> is thought to be gradually expanding in the country, the objective of this investigation is to explain why Peruvians sometimes prefer to use this expression instead of <estar + gerund>. I did an oral presentation on this subject and have recently conducted surveys among Peruvian university students. Results of the analysis of these surveys should be published in the near future.
- 2. I participated in the creation of a Spanish textbook in collaboration with two colleagues. In this project, I redacted the dialogues and short readings of each chapter. With another colleague, I am now writing a book for reading practice. I am in charge of the redaction of short readings about Spanish and Latin American festivities. Before joining these projects I have done research on teaching materials, especially, textbook creation.
