The main topic of my research has been the question of mood in subordinate clauses in Hungarian, and in particular the use of the Imperative mood in subordinate clauses. The research uses the notions and concepts of Cognitive Linguistics and aims to outline the theoretical framework and methodology of a research that may contribute to the description of some aspects of the topic that has received less attention so far. The broader context of the research is the context of subordinate clauses.

Last year, as part of the project, I reviewed the treatment of subordination in Cognitive Grammar, Construction Grammar and Mental Space Theory and applied the theoretical considerations of Cognitive Grammar to Hungarian subordinate clauses and the role of subordination in the constructions addressed.

As a side project, I was investigating the theoretical bases and practical implications of the L2 reading instruction method of extended reading, setting up some standards for the evaluation of extensive reading materials in Hungarian in order to evaluate existing materials and help the creation of future ones. I have realized a study on the entire text of all seven extensive readers published in Hungarian to date, examining in what measure the lexical features of these publications meet the requirements for the materials for extensive reading.
