3. Job Title : Specially Appointed Lecturer (Full-time)
4. Number of Positions : 1
5. Job Description : Engage in education and research on Thai language and Thai  
literature (Discretionary Labor System, Special Work Type : 40  
hours per week ), which includes teaching classes offered by  
the Graduate School of Language and Culture (Studies in  
Language and Society major)(herein referred to as “THE  
GRADUATE SCHOOL”) and the School of Foreign Studies for  
10-12 classes per week (one class lasts 90 minutes). Classes  
are assigned by THE GRADUATE SCHOOL.  
Candidates will be expected to engage in other duties required  
by THE GRADUATE SCHOOL and the School of Foreign  
Studies.
6. Starting Date : April 1st, 2021
7. Period of Employment : From the starting date to March 31st, 2023. The  
employment contract shall not be renewed. The successful  
applicant is requested to arrive in Japan and obtain the status  
of residence by the day before the starting date.

\* If you have work experience as a Limited Term Staff, Part-time Lecturer, etc. at Osaka University during the term from October 1st, 2020 to March 31st, 2021, the limit of extension of your contract period may be altered, in accordance with 'Regulations Pertaining to Contract Period of National University Corporation Osaka University Fixed-term Staff'. 8. Probation Period : 6 months

9. Employment Form : Discretionary Labor System, Special Work Type

10. Qualifications : An applicant is deemed qualified if s/he:

- (1) is a native speaker of or possesses native-like language proficiency in Thai language.
- (2) has general knowledge of the cultures and societies where Thai language is spoken.
- (3) has a Ph.D. or equivalent certification in Thai language, Thai language education or Thai literature.

12. Application Deadline : Application documents must arrive by September 24th, 2020.

13. Screening Method : Screening of application documents is conducted by faculty members of THE GRADUATE SCHOOL, Osaka University.

Short-listed candidates may also be invited to attend an interview at their own expense.

Candidates will be notified by mail of the screening decision (the successful candidate during December 2020 or later).

14. Employment Conditions :

- (1) The monthly salary may vary from 507,200 yen (minimum) to 558,925 yen (maximum). Commuting allowance will be

provided.

- (2) The appointed applicant will be provided with furnished residential facilities equipped with electricity, heating and water services throughout the term of the contract. Please note that the appointed candidate will be responsible for both rent and utility costs.
- (3) Upon assuming the post, the candidate will be provided with travel expenses.
- (4) Dependent allowance, bonus, retirement allowance and travel expenses for returning home will not be provided.

15. Insurance : The successful candidate will be enrolled in the National Public Service Personnel Mutual Aid Associations, Employment Insurance and Workers' Accident Compensation Insurance.
