Engage in education and research on Danish language, literature, culture and society (Discretionary Labor System, Special Work Type: 40 hours per week), which includes teaching classes offered by the Graduate School of Language and Culture (Studies in Language and Society major, herein referred to as "The Graduate School") and the School of Foreign Studies for 10-12 classes per week (one class lasts 90 minutes). Classes are assigned by The Graduate School.

Candidates will also be expected to engage in other duties required by The Graduate School, the School of Foreign Studies and the Danish Department.

 - (3) has a Danish degree (dr.phil., Ph.D., mag.art., cand.mag. or cand.phil.) in Danish language or Danish literature.
 - (4) has a sufficient number of publications in the fields of Danish language or literature.
 - (5) has at least two years of experience teaching Danish as a second or foreign language.

- (1) The monthly salary may vary from 507,200 yen (minimum) to 558,925 yen (maximum). A commuting allowance will be provided.
- (2) The appointed applicant will be provided with furnished residential facilities equipped with electricity, gas and water services throughout the term of the contract. Please note that the appointed candidate will be responsible for both rent and utility costs.
- (3) Upon assuming the post, the candidate will be provided with relocation expenses.
