At this time, the Graduate School of Language and Culture, Studies in Language and Society is looking to recruit a scholar in this particular area who can also help to improve language education. 2. Place of Work: Minoh Campus, Osaka University (3-5-10 Semba Higashi, Minoh-shi, Osaka-fu, Japan)

*Candidates may also be required to teach classes at Toyonaka Campus, Osaka University (Toyonaka City, Osaka).

3. Job Title: Specially Appointed Lecturer (Full-time)

4. Number of Positions: 1

5. Job Description: Engage in education and research on Indonesian language, literature and culture (Discretionary Labor System, Special Work Type : 40 hours per week), which includes teaching classes offered by the Graduate School of Language and Culture (Studies in Language and Society major)(herein referred to as “the Graduate School”) and the School of Foreign Studies for 10-12 classes per week (one class lasts 90 minutes). Classes are assigned by the Graduate School.

Candidates will also be expected to engage in other duties required by the Graduate School and the School of Foreign Studies.

6. Starting Date: April 1, 2022

7. Period of Employment: From the starting date to March 31, 2025. The initial contract may be renewed but not to extend beyond March 31, 2028(*). The successful applicant is requested to arrive in Japan and obtain the status of residence by the day before the starting date.

*If you have work experience as a Limited-term Staff Member, Part-time Lecturer, etc. at Osaka University during the term from October 1, 2021 to March 31, 2022, the limit of extension of your contract period may be altered, in accordance with 'Regulations Pertaining to Contract Period of National University Corporation Osaka University Fixed-term Staff'. 8. Probation Period: 6 months
9. Employment Form: Discretionary Labor System, Special Work Type
*Based on the 'Regulations Pertaining to Working Hours, Holidays and Leave for National University Corporation Osaka University Limited Term Staff.'
10. Qualifications: An applicant is deemed qualified if s/he:
 - (1) is a native speaker of or possesses native-like language proficiency in the Indonesian language.
 - (2) possesses a broad general knowledge of the cultures and societies of the areas in which Indonesian is spoken.
 - (3) possesses a Ph.D., M.A. or equivalent qualification in Indonesian language studies, studies of other languages spoken in Indonesia or Indonesian literature.
 - (4) has experience teaching Indonesian to foreigners at universities or other institutions of higher education.
11. Application Documents:
 - (1) Curriculum vitae (Attachment 1)
 - (2) List of main publications (Books, articles, etc.) (Attachment 2)For items (1) and (2), please use the attached forms (Attachments 1 and 2) and carefully fill in all of the necessary information. Applicants should also provide their current address, phone/fax number, and e-mail address, so that direct contact may be made during the administrative procedure. Application documents will not be returned.
12. Application Deadline: Application documents must arrive by September 21, 2021.
13. Screening Method: Screening of application documents is conducted by faculty members of the Graduate School, Osaka University. Short-listed candidates may be invited to attend an interview at their own expense. Candidates will be notified by mail of the screening decision (the successful candidate will be notified from mid-November 2021).
14. Employment Conditions:
 - (1) The monthly salary may vary from 507,200 yen (minimum) to

558,925 yen (maximum). A commuting allowance will be provided.

- (2) The appointed applicant will be provided with a residential facility equipped with rental furniture, electricity, gas, and water services throughout the term of the contract. Please note that the appointed candidate will be responsible for the cost of the rent, furniture, and utilities.
- (3) Upon assuming the post, the candidate will be provided with relocation expenses.
- (4) Dependent allowances, bonuses, a retirement allowance and travel expenses for returning to the candidate's home country will not be provided.

15. Insurance: The successful candidate will be enrolled in the National Public Service Personnel Mutual Aid Associations, Employment Insurance and Workers' Accident Compensation Insurance.
